Who you are:

- You enjoy working outdoors and teaching swimming lessons in open water,
- You have a minimum of 2 years teaching fun and creative swimming lessons in Canada,
- You are a supportive and productive leader with a high level of adaptability,
- You are a strong instructor and positive team member,
- You can provide constructive guidance to instructors,
- Are organized, assertive, and have excellent time management,
- You are a problem solver, flexible in unique situations, and
- You can work under minimal supervision.

Duties & Responsibilities:

- Performs all duties and responsibilities of Swim Instructors,
- Instruction of the Lifesaving Society's Bronze Family program, if required.
- Facilitates sessional staff training.
- Responsible for weekly lesson administration duties, including preparing instructor materials, collecting participant registrations and additional forms, and lesson statistics.
- Additional administration tasks, such as collection of employee timesheets, responding to public and participant enquiries, and inventory tracking,
- Provides instructor support, feedback and evaluation throughout each lesson set.
- Creates a safe, welcoming and supportive environment for all families and instructors.
- Ensure accommodation is well maintained.
- Ensures that proper safety procedures are followed and in cases of emergency, performs first aid, water rescues and other lifesaving skills and techniques.
- Recording of incidents that involve self, staff and participants.
- Performs related duties as required.

Qualifications and Experience:

- Possession of a valid Saskatchewan Class 5 Driver's Licence.
- Current Lifesaving Society Bronze Cross or National Lifeguard.
- Current Standard First Aid & CPR-C/AED.
- Current Lifesaving Society Swim Instructor.
- Current Lifesaving Society Lifesaving Instructor and Bronze Examiner Appointment.
- Lifesaving Society Bronze Mentor (preferred).
- 10 months supervisory experience in an aquatic setting (preferred).

Working Conditions:

- Duties are conducted outdoors, at the assigned locations. The ideal candidate will be able to adapt to various weather conditions to ensure all lessons are meaningful to participants.
- Team Leaders are on-site support for instructors and participants, and will work with minimal supervision.
- Overnight, camp accommodation will be provided from Sunday at 4pm to Saturday at 9am (in a shared, powered camper trailer on-site). Sleeping gear, food, etc. will not be provided.

Hours:

May – June: Flexible days, 10-20 hours per week.

July – August: Monday to Friday, 35-40 hours per week.

Wage: \$21.00-\$25.00 per hour, based on experience.

Administrative Allowance: Wage rate of 30 minutes per lesson set, if/when teaching lessons.

Travel Allowance: \$75 per week, when travel is required to lesson locations.

This position requires the successful candidate to provide a satisfactory Vulnerable Sector and Criminal Record Check as a condition of employment.
